

HOME SCHOOL AGREEMENT

1 The parent will:

- i) ensure that their child attends school as required by law;
- ii) notify the school of any known absence on every day of absence and complete the notification of absence form on return to school to explain the absence;
- iii) comply with the Governors' policy on leave of absence unless there are very exceptional circumstances which have been discussed with the Headteacher in advance;
- iv) ensure that their child arrives at school before the start of registration (8.50am, 1.30pm), equipped for learning, wearing the correct school uniform and tidy in appearance;
- v) ensure that the school is made aware of any significant changes, concerns or problems which may affect their son/daughter's learning and/or behaviour;
- vi) support the school's policies and procedures in relation to discipline and behaviour;
- vii) support the school's policies in relation to Health and Safety, including no driving/parking on site at peak times;
- viii) support their child in homework and other opportunities for home learning;
- ix) make a weekly check of the diary and communicate with the school as appropriate;
- x) endeavour to attend parents' information and consultation evenings and discussions about progress;
- xi) support the school in working towards its aims as stated in the school prospectus.

2 The school will:

- i) contact parents if there is a problem with attendance and/or punctuality;
- ii) let parents know about any concerns or problems that affect a student's work or behaviour;
- iii) provide a broad and balanced curriculum within the resources available;
- iv) set, mark and monitor homework;
- v) make a weekly check of the diary and communicate with parents as appropriate;
- vi) provide regular assessments of students and annual reports to parents;
- vii) arrange parents' consultation evenings during which progress will be discussed;
- viii) keep parents informed about school activities through regular newsletters, notices about special events, the school calendar, students' diaries and information evenings;
- ix) have high expectations of students in terms of learning, commitment and behaviour;
- x) endeavour to achieve our aims as stated in the school prospectus and to monitor and evaluate progress within the context of the school development plan.

3 The student will:

- i) attend school as required by law;
- ii) arrive before registration (8.50am, 1.30pm), be equipped for learning, wear the correct school uniform and be tidy in appearance;
- iii) try to talk to a parent and/or teacher if there is a concern or problem which may affect learning and/or behaviour;
- iv) follow the school's code of conduct;
- v) complete homework and classwork to the best of their ability;
- vi) make proper use of the school diaries;
- vii) try to attend parents' evenings where appropriate and other discussions about progress;
- viii) be responsible where appropriate in delivering correspondence between home and school;
- ix) have high expectations of themselves, and others;
- x) work within the context of the school community in trying to achieve our aims;
- xi) to respect school property and that of others.
