Year 11 students at Ranelagh School are celebrating the success of their hard work with an excellent set of GCSE examination results.

In the second year of the new, tougher, examinations in English and Mathematics 82% of Year 11 students achieved grade 4 or better. An impressive 24% of students achieved a grade 7 or higher in both English and Mathematics.

Headteacher, Beverley Stevens, said, “There was a very real sense of uncertainty surrounding this year’s GCSE results. Staff have worked enormously hard to manage students’ concerns and prepare them for the raft of new examinations with their greater difficulty and significantly increased content.
