<p style="text-align: center;">1 <i>Jesus Is Condemned</i></p> <p>THINK POINT: Jesus knew what it meant to stand alone in front of those who hated or feared him.</p>	<p>LRC (Old Building) – go through the doors to the library and then look behind you.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">2 <i>Jesus Accepts His Cross</i></p> <p>THINK POINT: Jesus picked up his cross, even though he knew it would lead to his death.</p>	
<p style="text-align: center;">3 <i>Jesus Falls For The First Time</i></p> <p>THINK POINT: Jesus knew how it felt to struggle and to fall, to face temptation and to fight it.</p>	
<p style="text-align: center;">4 <i>Jesus Meets His Mother</i></p> <p>THINK POINT: Jesus looked through the crowd and saw his mother's eyes. Her love and compassion helped him.</p>	
<p style="text-align: center;">5 <i>Simon Carries The Cross Of Jesus</i></p> <p>THINK POINT: Jesus knew what it meant to depend on someone and rely on their help.</p>	
<p style="text-align: center;">6 <i>Veronica Wipes The Face Of Jesus</i></p> <p>THINK POINT: Jesus knew what it meant to be in pain and to cry out, for sweat to pour from his brow in agony.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Entrance to the Centenary Building</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">7 <i>Jesus Falls For The Second Time</i></p> <p>THINK POINT: Jesus stumbled and fell, lost strength, and became fragile.</p>	



8 *Jesus Speaks To The Women Of Jerusalem*

THINK POINT: Jesus cared and spoke out even on the road to his death. He knew and felt the suffering of others.



9 *Jesus Falls For The Third Time*

THINK POINT: Jesus felt the darkness around him, the crowds surrounded and crushed him, he fell once more.



10 *Jesus Is Stripped*

THINK POINT: Jesus faced the worst of humiliations and insults. He was denied dignity and was not treated like a human.



11 *Jesus Is Nailed To The Cross*

THINK POINT: Jesus hung broken and beaten. In pain, he felt abandoned and cried out.



12 *Jesus Dies On The Cross*

THINK POINT: Jesus knew what it was like to feel abandoned, lost, and afraid.



13 *Jesus Is Taken Down From The Cross*

THINK POINT: Jesus knew what it meant to have friends, who risked their own lives to take his body from the cross.



14 *Jesus In The Tomb*

THINK POINT: Jesus - in the darkness of the tomb - was surrounded by grief, and by fear.



15 *The Resurrection*

The Stations of the Cross are used within the Church (regularly in the Roman Catholic tradition, as well as the Anglican Church) to enable us to engage with Jesus' suffering in the last hours of his life. This series of 15 Stations of the Cross are hung around the school. They are printed replicas on canvas of a permanent display of the same 15 6ft paintings hung in Blackburn Cathedral. The artist is Penny Warden – her daughter was a student at the school.
